The Second Sunday in Lent Genesis 12.1-4a; Psalm 121; Romans 4.1-5, [6-12], 13-17; And one of John 3.1-17 or Mark 9.2-9 or Luke 9.28-36

In the gospel of John we are reminded of the power of being born again, to be born of water and Spirit (v. 5). Nicodemus sought Jesus in order to understand the things of God.
