


Pentecost (Whitsunday) - Sunday 4 June 2017

We hear from St Luke of the 'Birth of the Church' where the Holy Spirit descends on the believers who then speak in many of the languages of the known world. Today it is the same: the Church proclaims the Gospel of our Lord in hundreds of tongues – using time-honoured liturgical languages (Ge'ez, Old Church Slavonic, Coptic, Syriac and Latin among them) as well as everyday tongues spoken in the street.

Pray that the Church continues to proclaim Jesus Christ in ways that are accessible for all.

Give thanks for the work of those who translate the Scriptures into languages that have not yet had a version of the Bible.

Ouestion 1—How long have you worshipped in this parish?


