Today's We continue to hear Jesus' instruction to the community, as he reminds Peter, as leader of the church, how often he should forgive by telling the Parable of the Unforgiving Servant.

10,000 denarii was the equivalent to about 200,000 years' wages! How bountiful is our heavenly Father's mercy that he might forgive us, if we only ask. The parable serves as a powerful reminder: we must remember to forgive, as we too are forgiven.

<u>Pray that</u> we might be witnesses of the good news of God's magnanimous forgiveness, and extend that grace to others.


PRAYER FOR A NEW MINISTER
