

Pray for self-awareness as an individual and as a congregation; Surely, we are not blind, are we? (John 9.40).



- Letter from Bishop Ian advising change of general name of diocese changed at Synod to 'Anglican Church of Central and Western NSW'
- Synod Report: It is hopeful that the debt will be resolved early next year and Synod set for specially meeting Feb 17, 2018, Restructure of Diocese into 3 Archdeaconry's with 2 mission district in each to go ahead, Diocesan financial reports change to be more transparent, investigation into insurances and alternatives for next synod, First nation recognition in our churches discussed, Mission partnership with Solomon's Diocese of Ysabel encouraged on parish by parish level, BIC to set diocesan budget, "Endowment of the See" Fund discussed
- Date for Fr Robert and Rev Beth's Parish Farwell discussed.
- Reports from, Elong, Uarbry, Mendooran, Fete, Rector and Treasurer received.
- August income \$16243 Expenses \$10271 Surplus \$5972. Year to date Deficit -\$607 [171015]
