- Monies received directly by the PC from other Anglican Churches are to be allocated to a maximum of \$1000/applicant;
- A local area Appeal Letter to raise funds to replace windows at St Laurence Church Neilrex is under consideration;
- Fr Robert advised that the parish has had a large number of funeral services, and that requests have been received regarding several baptisms in the next few months;
- Parish Website costs \$90/year donated by Fr Robert and is due for renewal at the end of 2017. PC is considering taking on website.
- Painting of small area in Coolah Rectory approved.
- Compassion Christmas Greetings sent to our Compassion Children.
- Coolah, Dunedoo, Neilrex and AWA gave reports to PC.
- Valentine's Day Dinner set for February 2018 with guest speakers Sam and Jenny Bailey to be invited.
